Amboseli

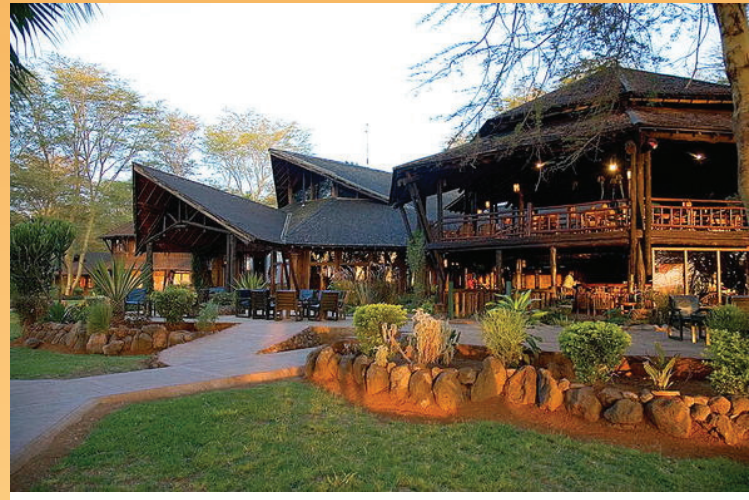
- Large herds of African Elephants.
- Spectacular views of Mt. Kilimanjaro, mostly visible early in the morning and late in the evening.
- Observation Hill - While at the Observation Point, one has an aerial view of the large elephant herds from the top of the Hill and a clear picture of Mt. Kilimanjaro.
- Birdlife with over 420 species of birds.
- Variety of animal Life from lions, buffaloes, leopards, giraffes, wildebeests, gazelles, topis ,hyenas ,dik-dik ,Oribis, foxes, and many other species.

Day 2:

After a restful night, set off on a road trip to Amboseli National Park, where you check into the luxurious Serena Lodge for a full-board stay (all meals included), and crown the day with a thrilling afternoon game drive.

Day 3:

Greet the day with a scenic breakfast experience and create more exciting memories at Amboseli when you set off for thrilling morning or afternoon game drives.



ATTRACTIONS

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Day 4:

After two exciting days at Amboseli; get on the road for a scenic trip to Aberdares National Park, located in Kenya's central region. On arrival, check in to the Aberdares Country Club for a full-board overnight stay; a haven, offering captivating game drives and appetising meals.

Day 5:

(another day another, exciting adventure) After breakfast, set off to Northern Kenya's fascinating destination the Samburu National Reserve. On arrival, enjoy a delicious lunch at the Saruni Camp; and after lunch, head out for a scenic afternoon game drive. Fun Fact: Samburu is home to rare and indigenous species in Kenya. Keep an eye out for the Reticulated Giraffe, Gerenuk (a.k.a. the giraffe gazelle), Grevy's Zebra, East African Oryx, White Headed Mousebird, Somali Bee Eater and the Somali Ostrich.

*Fun Fact:*

ATTRACTIONS

Samburu

- View the unusual species rarely seen outside of this region,
- Grevy's zebra with its distinctive narrow stripes,
- Reticulated giraffe with its geometric pattern,
- The shy long-necked Gerenuk which stands erect on its hind legs to feed
- The blue-necked Somali ostrich,
- The beisa oryx with Long straight horns.

Day 6:

Samburu has a lot to offer: Get ready for full-day activities at Kalama Conservancy, with thrilling activities and drives. Later, indulge in a delectable dinner and overnight stay at Saruni Samburu Camp.

**Day 7:**

Wake up for a breathtaking day out at Mount Kenya National Park. Check-in to the scenic SweetWaters Tented Camp for a full-board overnight stay.

During your stay, get to explore SweetWaters Tented Camp, which is also home to the world-renowned Ol Pejeta Conservancy, where you get to tour and learn about the camp's eco-efforts to protect endangered species, including the last northern white rhinos and the chimps sanctuary.

ATTRACTIONS

Mt. Kenya

OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY

- ☉ It is home to the last two northern white rhino on the planet
- ☉ Ol Pejeta is the largest black rhino sanctuary in East Africa. It is also the only place in Kenya to see chimpanzees.
- ☉ It is home to the Big five and other species such as giraffes, baboons, hippos and hyenas. And many more.

Day 8:

After breakfast, continue your journey to Lake Nakuru National Park for an exciting day-safari; and check in to Sarova Lion Hill Lodge for a relaxing night. Fun Fact: Lake Nakuru National Park is home to Lake Nakuru (one of the saline lake systems in the Great Rift Valley). This makes the park ideal for bird watching and game drives for impressive views of pink flamingoes, rhinos, waterbucks, impalas, colobus monkeys, spotted hyenas, zebras, gazelles, leopards, lions, hippos (and more).



ATTRACTIONS

Lake Nakuru

- ☉ Magnificent physical features such as the Makalia falls.
- ☉ Over 500 species; greater and lesser flamingoes, Black-tailed godwit, Crab-plover, Eastern imperial eagle, Maccoa duck, Montane white-eye, White-headed vulture and many more.
- ☉ Lake Nakuru national park is made up of many attractive physical features such as Makalia falls, lake Nakuru and hills.
- ☉ Beautiful scenery.
- ☉ Over 50 species of animals Black rhino, white rhinos, Rothschild's giraffe, waterbucks, lions, predators, cheetah, Burchell's zebra, Thomson's gazelle, hippopotamuses, hyena, and much more.

Day 9:

Head out for thrilling game drives and immerse yourself in the wonders of the iconic Masai Mara National Reserve, and for an unforgettable full-board stay at Base-camp Masai Mara.

Day 10:

Embark on a day rich in nature and arts-and-culture. Spend the day on morning and afternoon game drives and experience the local culture and artistry at the women's handicraft centre at a local Masai village.

ATTRACTIONS

Masai Mara

- 📍 Home to lion, leopard, elephant and buffalo, zebra, giraffe, hyena, eland and gazelle. Also home to the endangered Rhino.
- 📍 Large concentrations of elephant, buffalo and giraffe. The park is also home to over 450 bird species. The Mara is home to the largest collection of lions in Kenya. Additionally there's the 7th wonder of the world that takes place annually between 7 July to October when thousands of weeldebust among other wild cross the Mara river from the Serengeti plains in Tanzania to the awaiting lions, leopards on the Kenyan side. A spectacle to behold indeed. (Between July and October).

Day 11:

Top-up your Masai Mara safari experience - you have the option of a morning balloon flight and a sumptuous bush breakfast (or) choose to relax at the camp and under the stars, by the evening campfire. Look forward to scenic sunrise views and bird's eye views - of rolling savanna- scapes', lion prides, herds of zebras, giraffes, elephants, antelopes crossing the plains: and flocks of birds across the skyline for a truly unforgettable experience.

**Day 12:**

As your safari winds up; enjoy a drive back to Nairobi for a city tour of Nairobi and a satisfying dinner at a select city restaurant. After dinner, you'll head for an airport transfer, for your flight home.
